

Oak Hill Pool Closure Guidelines

- The temperature must be above 70 degrees to open the pool. Wind chill will be taken into consideration. The manager, in consultation with pool board members, will determine if the pool will open at 1:00 p.m. The manager and board members will continue to monitor the weather every two hours to determine if the pool can open later in the day.
- If there is severe weather in the forecast before the pool is open for the day (thunderstorms, tornado watch, etc.) the manager, in consultation with the pool board members, will determine if the pool will open at 1:00 p.m. The manager and board members will continue to monitor the weather reports every two hours to determine if the pool can open later in the day.
- If lightning is present in the area, no swimmers will be allowed back in the water for 30 minutes following the last lightning event when lightning is seen and thunder is heard.
- In case of severe weather occurring after the pool is open for the day, the pool staff will inform swimmers if the pool will close during operating hours. For safety reasons, staff will ensure that swimmers are given notice if they need to call home for a ride.
- There will be no refund of the \$5 guest fee for weather-related or other closures of the pool.
- The Oak Hill Ralston pool manager and the pool board of directors reserve the right to close the pool for any reason they determine to be necessary.
