Policy for Use of Flotation devices (Floaties)

(established 07/02/2019)

1. No flotation devices of any kind will be allowed in the Diving Pool.
2. Only small (child-sized) flotation devices will be allowed in the Baby/Toddler Pool.
3. In the main swimming pool (3'-6'):
If there are less than 20 people in the main pool, any size flotation device will be allowed, as long as it does not interfere with the other swimmers.

If there are 20 or more people in the main pool, only flotation devices that are made to hold one adult will be allowed in the pool.

4. Please ensure that if you or your family members are on a flotation device and are not good swimmers, that their floatie remains in water that is not deeper than the top of their shoulders. It is nearly impossible for a lifeguard to see a person who has ended up underneath a floatie.
